





## MRS. VENTHAM'S BOARDING SCHOOL

Mary Hillyer was born in 1816, daughter of Hannah and George, a rent collector. In 1823, the final year that Mrs. Ventham's school near Winchester, was open, she made this sampler. A number of these samplers have turned up over the years with similar elements, in particular the farmhouse and barn, and the intricately worked animals and people below.













The Scarlet Letter has reproduced one of the Ventham samplers- Anna Maria Barfoot and I have recently discovered Mary's sampler which is in very poor condition but displays a delightful cast of characters including a dog tugging on a gentleman's coat tails, a woman balancing a basket on her head, hens and chicks pecking, a girl milking a cow, and a boy pushing a wheelbarrow full of hay. Once the sampler has been cleaned and conserved it will be offered as a chart in 2019.

## **ANN FORREST 1757**



This very delicate Scottish sampler with its bold color scheme was designed with a four sided stylized honeysuckle border surrounding horizontal rows of illuminated alphabets and double running stitch motifs.

## **SUSANNA PARKER 1761**



This mid eighteenth century English band sampler features rows of alphabets, vowels, numerals, pattern bands, verses and crowns, executed in cross, petit point, eyelet and counted satin stitches.

This sweet little sampler is very likely Scottish, as the surname "Nimmo" suggests. The reproduction is stitched on linen with cross, petit point (cross stitch over one thread of linen), straight, and counted satin stitches. This is a rare sampler made by a young boy.
